LBEF Internship cum Placement Drive - 2023 edition, in association with Talent Connect, was successfully conducted on 7th April in which 20+ reputed companies of Nepal participated.

70+ students of BSc. IT and BBM of LBEF participated out of which 35+ students received 2nd round interview call letters on the spot with a strike ratio of about 60%. At one side, couple of students grabbed more than 1 offer while Ms. Riya

Sharma (BBM) got final job offer from 7 different companies.

All the participating companies expressed their interest in recruiting LBEF students and appreciated their skills and knowledge in their respective domain areas. Few companies expressed their high interest in entering into a long-term association with LBEF in order to meet their growing workforce requirements. In future, these companies will partner with LBEF for developing a capsule/boot camp program for LBEF students and absorbing them as final placement after the successful completion of their degree.
